Membership is individual and not transferable from one person to another. Dues and an application fee of \$20 (or \$5 for students) are nonrefundable. Annual dues payments cover one calendar year. All memberships expire on December 31 of each year. New members whose applications are accepted prior to July 1 pay full-year dues (\$170). New member applications accepted on or after July 1 pay \$95, which covers membership through December 31. Renewing members are eligible to renew within the current calendar year at a dues rate of \$150. Individuals who wish to reinstate their membership after one calendar year of expiration are subject to the rules and procedures prescribed for an original (new) membership application. Annual renewal dues for students are \$20 per year.

Note: Contributions or gifts to ASIS are nondeductible as charitable contributions. Your dues payments may be deductible as an ordinary business expense; however, a percent of your membership dues is not deductible as a result of ASIS lobbying activities on behalf of its members. The exact amount that is nondeductible is disclosed in your welcome letter, on your dues renewal form, and in the FAQs on the ASIS Web site. Please consult with your tax advisor regarding any tax issues.
