Our April 2022 member spotlight falls on Jeffrey (Jeff) Friedel, CPP.

While currently our Chapter 79 Treasurer, Jeff also serves on the Annual Seminar Committee as well as previously serving as a Chapter 79 membership committee chair. He has an AA degree from HACC and a BA from Elizabethtown College

Jeff's professional career began with the Pennsylvania State Police (PSP), starting as Trooper on patrol assignment, but he then took advantage of opportunities in the department that included crime scene processing (the real version of TV's CSI) and all aspects of forensic investigation. Through his years in the Bureau of Forensic Services Jeff rose to the rank of Captain, was qualified as an expert witness, and developed a number of forensic training programs to assist in honing the forensic skills of new and inexperienced law enforcement officers.

At retirement from the PSP, Jeff had the interest and energy to take on a new assignment. He landed at the Hotel Hershey as the Director, Safety & Security. As Jeff sees it, "I transitioned from 25 years in law enforcement to a second career in hospitality security. Law enforcement and security share several similarities, whether it's the citizens of the Commonwealth or the guests and employees of Hershey Entertainment & Resorts, the focus is on being an effective communicator while protecting people and assets."

In 2019, Jeff was tapped to lead the safety and security operations of both the Hotel Hershey and the Hershey Lodge. With a staff of 45 reports, he promotes training and mentoring to improve job knowledge, as well as professional growth of all team members both new and tenured. This leadership process allows Jeff the time and opportunity to partner with all the other departmental leaders at the two resorts.

In his current role, Jeff has the advantage of benchmarking not only ASIS, but with industry associates and relationships he's developed through networking and professional development. Living nearby, Jeff, his wife and two sons are active in the community. Watching football and fishing with his boys provides that important bonding time outside of work. Jeff also volunteers in

other rewarding opportunities such as Project Fellowship with the Milton Hershey School and as a board member with PA Crime Stoppers.

Not surprisingly, Jeff's 'go forward' plan, "I will continue to seek training opportunities, grow my professional network and enhance my knowledge of the industry through ASIS and other professional organizations."
